

### FAQ's for RFP-TTC Lighting Retrofitting

1. On page 3, Item L states “all bids must be submitted by a contractor licensed as a General Contractor...” Question: The scope of work is electrical and will require an electrical contractor to complete and permit if necessary, Will a Texas Electrical Contractor license be acceptable?

A: Yes

2. On page 4, The selection criteria. Question: What if any weights/points will be applied?

A: 30% price, 30% Reputation, 30% Quality, 10% Contractors past relationship

3. On page 9, Item AB states “repairs and construction involved in the scope of work are subject to the Fair Labor Standards Act...” Question: Is this project using prevailing wage rates?

A: Yes. The Travis County prevailing wage under the Davis-Bacon Act

4. On page 11, paragraph 1, states “vendor should supply 300 bridging clips for three lamp fixtures.” Question: Can you provide a cut sheet or product code needed for this project?

A: No. The contractor should supply a satisfactory compatible product in the bid.

5. On page 11, Item B, states “contractor must be licensed as a master electrician with the TDLR and must be registered with the City of Austin..” Question: Would this be a registered vendor with City of Austin or registered as an electrical contractor in the City of Austin.

A: No. Not a City of Austin registered vendor. Rather, licensed to perform electrical work within the City of Austin.

6. Will there be a bid opening for this RFP?

A: Yes. Proposals will be accepted until the close of business at 5:00 PM on the 24<sup>th</sup> of March. The bid opening will be at 8:30 AM on March 27<sup>th</sup> in the TTC building. Room: Buchanan Dam. (See the help desk at the TTC for assistance locating the room location if needed)
