Additional Information to Consider When Registering for the Annual State Dyslexia Summer Institute:

1. **Registration Fee:** There is a registration fee for this year’s State Dyslexia Summer Institute. You will be asked to choose one of the following categories at the beginning of the registration process:

Public and Charter School Personnel – Currently employed by a public or charter school, or retired at the end of this school year from a public or charter school. This would include if you are employed by an Education Service Center.	\$70.00
All Others – This would include those employed by a private school or educational entity, those providing private dyslexia therapy or assessment, and parents.	\$100.00

Please be prepared to pay by either purchase order, check, or credit card when you register.

2. **Break-Out Selections:** This year you will select your break-out sessions when you register, which is different from previous years.

 - ❖ Note: The system will not allow you to switch to another session after submitting and processing the registration.
3. **Registering Multiples:** If someone is registering multiple people then they need to make sure they have the authority to do so in our system. Below are the options to secure that authority:
